Question:

What will I need to attend the 2022 Virtual Workshop?

Answer:

Once you register for the Workshop, you will automatically be set up with access to the virtual platform. We will provide each registrant with login information as we get closer to the actual event. This platform will be the one central location to access each day's educational sessions, roundtable cohort group chats, and all other materials for the Workshop.

Question:

How much does it cost to participate?

Answer:

Registration is complimentary for current active members of NCSFA. Additional attendees from our member organizations are just \$100. Nonmember registration is \$150. All fees are in U.S. dollars. For those unable to attend, on-demand access to educational sessions will be available for \$50 (members) and \$80 (nonmembers).

Question:

What are the dates and times for the Virtual Workshop?

Answer:

Programming for the 2021 Workshop will run daily from Tuesday, October 19, to Friday, October 22, beginning at 1:00pm Eastern and concluding by 5:30pm Eastern daily, depending on the day's programming.

What is the Pre-Workshop Education Session?

Answer:

The pre-Workshop session (October 13 and 14 from 1:00-3:00 pm Eastern) will be webinars 1 and 2 of the EV Champion Training. The EV Champion Training Program is a four-part training series that covers everything you need to plan for the adoption of electric vehicles in your fleet. Webinars 3 and 4 will be offered in November and December as virtual events.
